Overview

Making them think! is a network for teachers in Buckinghamshire schools. It is an AMSP-funded project, allowing teachers of Core Maths and of A level Mathematics and Further Mathematics to meet, collaborate and to share best practice. The programme is planned in response to teacher requests and is currently alternating between sessions focused on Core Maths and sessions on A level Mathematics Further Mathematics. We meet half-terminally and sessions are a mixture of presentations and discussion.

Core Maths Group

An opportunity to contribute to the planning of this year's workgroup as well as sharing the outcomes of last year's meetings.

Also sharing experiences from this year's examinations: successes and areas for development.
